

The tradition of song is deeply rooted in Methodism. In his *Directions for Singing* (John Wesley, 1761), Wesley lays out seven foundations for the way hymns should be sung in the Methodist Church. Of his seven tenets, I must confess that number three is my favorite: *Sing lustily and with good courage*. Beware of singing as if you were half dead, or half asleep; but lift up your voice with strength. Be no more afraid of your voice now, nor more ashamed of its being heard, than when you sung [sic] the songs of Satan.

Throughout my 65 years at Shady Grove UMC, joyful singing has always been an important part of the worship experience, and I cannot remember a time when the church choir was not an active and vibrant part of church life here at Shady Grove. If you've ever considered being in the choir, there's no better time than now to join in. Our requirements are simple: *love the Lord and love to sing!*We currently meet at 10:30 a.m. on most Sunday mornings in the practice room, and we'd love to have you join us!
